Dear Parents, greetings and best wishes to Your families, from Fr.Luke Krzanowski and our Catechetical Team. I hope that you have a good summer. The time is coming, when once again we have to think of our Religious Education Program. We are sending to you this letter to remind you of a few very important matters.

First of all, we would like to welcome You to our Religious Education Program 2011-2012. As we enter this new season of Religious Education, I hope that you will support me with helping your children and your families to grow in faith, to deepen your faith, love and trust in God and his church.

First a few announcements:

- The start of the class time will be the same as last year from **4.30 to 5.30 for Confirmation Class** and **5.30pm to 7pm** for all other classes. ***The opening class for all grades will be on 25 of September, at 5.30pm which will include a special presentation about La Salette.***
- The Registration fee of each child is \$35.00 per child with \$100.00 Max. per family.
- We always welcome parents who would like to help in classes and we are in need of teachers.
- I would like to make a personal plea to all the parents of the RE students - PLEASE try to bring your child to every class and to bring them **ON TIME**. This is very important as we start class with prayer and arriving late disrupts class. Thank you very much for your help and understanding.
- **VERY IMPORTANT REQUIREMENT !!!! - IT IS MANDATORY FOR THE CHILDREN PREPARING FOR THE FIRST HOLY COMMUNION TO START IN THE FIRST GRADE (WE WILL NOT ACCEPT CHILDREN DIRECTLY TO THE SECOND GRADE) - SIMILARLY, PREPERATION PROGRAM FOR THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION STARTS IN THE GRADE TEN. IF FOR SOME REASONS YOU HAVE DIFFICULTIES ATTENDING THE CLASSES PLEASE TALK TO ME AND I WILL TRY TO HELP**
- **Please also let us know, if your child will not be able to attend class.**
- **Please don't forget to have your children wash their hands and use the antibacterial soap before coming to class.**
- As you can see the schedule on the other side – we will have time for masses, confession, and also – like last year - I'm planning to have Advent Activity Day with a Nativity Play . I want to invite your children to take part in these great events (we need actors, readers, singers, musicians and parents are welcome too)
- Please support us, and help us. Please show interests in your children work, see what they do and ask them questions and talk to the catechists. Teaching starts at home.
- Perhaps I don't need to remind you how important it is to attend Sunday Masses, to pray with your children and to give them an example of living faith. You parents are the first teachers and only with your help and support we will be able to pass our faith into their hearts.
